Information Desk – If you would like more information about Eden, or how to become more involved, please visit the Information Desk in the Concourse Area.

Sunday Prayer Meetings – You are welcome to join the church prayer meeting at 9:30am in room 4 before the morning service.

Communion – We believe that baptism should precede taking communion but recognise that there is a diversity of conviction among Bible-believing Christians on this. So we welcome all who love the Lord Jesus and are in good standing with their local church to join us in communion.

Student Supper – During student term-time a meal is served after the evening service. Great for hanging out in small groups and thinking through how God's word applies to us.

20s & 30s Group meets on the 4th Sunday of the month for lunch and also organises social activities. These are advertised in the weekly service bulletin or by email. To join visit eden-cambridge.org/20sand30s-list.

Open House meets at 8pm on 1st Sunday of every month in a church member's home. Come and get to know each other better. See the bulletin for venue.

GROUPS FOR CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE

Crèche is available for 0–2-year-olds throughout the service in the downstairs crèche room. Until the service break under 3s can also use the crèche, if there is space.

Discovery Club is for pre- and primary school aged children and meets after the morning break in rooms as advertised in the bulletin.

Impact is our group for 11–14 year olds and meets during school term off-site after the morning break.

GAP is for 14–18 year olds and meets on 1st & 3rd Sundays in school term after the morning break.

Housegroups meet on Thursdays at 8pm in various locations around Cambridge for Bible study, prayer and fellowship except on 1st Thursday of the month. One group meets at 10:45am on 1st & 3rd Thursday.

Prayer meetings We encourage Eden regulars to go to the monthly prayer meeting on 1st Thursday at 8pm at Eden. There are also prayer groups for our missionaries.

Women on Wednesday * meets on the 1st & 3rd Wednesday from 10–11:30am for a time of fellowship, Bible study and prayer. A crèche is provided.

Friday Night Impact * meets on Fridays from 8–9:30pm for a fun-packed programme and a short time looking at what the Bible says to us. Open to anyone in school year 7–10.

GAP Housegroup * meets on Wednesdays from 7:45–9pm for Bible study. Open to all in school year 10 upwards.

Tiddlywinks * meets on Monday & Tuesday mornings from 10–11:30am for parents, carers and their children, whether attenders at Eden or not. Toys, craft, songs and stories.

Explore Course meets Tuesdays from 7:45–9pm for 6 weeks. Explore provides the opportunity to discover more about the basics of the Christian faith in an informal setting and is ideal for people who are investigating Christianity.

Not So Young Lunch (for over 65s) meets at Eden on 4th Wednesday of the month at 12.30 for lunch and a short talk.

International Women's Group * meets Fridays from 10am–12noon for a varied programme of activities. IWG is open to women from all cultures who would like to meet others. A crèche for pre-school children is provided.

Eden Café 2nd & 4th Saturday 11am–1pm. Chat, coffee and cakes as an outreach to those passing by the church.

Fight Club * is a group for men, meeting on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday at 7:15am for breakfast, Bible study and prayer.
