1. What are we here for? (6-8a)

We were made to know God and serve him by ruling the world for him, in perfect harmony.

Genesis 1:26-28; 2:15: 'The First Great Commission.'

2. Why isn't it like that then? (8b)

Human rebellion has disrupted our relationship with God and our rule over the world.

Genesis 3:17-19; 'The Fall.' 9:1-3:

3. So is there any hope? (9-10a)

Yes, but not in angels or ourselves but in Jesus

- Jesus' birth and life.
- Jesus' death as our substitute.
- Jesus' resurrection and present seat in glory.
- Jesus' plan to bring 'many sons to glory'.

Application: Look at Jesus and...

- join Jesus' redemption project in all its fullness, fusing the First and Second Great Commissions. Matthew 28:16-20.
- endure suffering now for the sake of permanent and perfect glory in the future. Romans 8:17; 2 Corinthians 4:16-17.
