 - The Beauty Myth is literally an illusion.
 - The Beauty Myth is an idol which makes false promises.
- 2. by being renewed in our thinking about beauty:
 - looking at others differently: Proverbs 16: 31
 - being transformed as we gaze at Christ, 2 Corinthians 3: 18
 - accepting our bodies as God's gift and care for them appropriately Ephesians 5: 29
 - nurturing outward modesty and inner beauty 1 Peter 3: 3-5a, 1 Timothy 3:9-10.
