Stating the Doctrine:

Before creation God chose a fixed number of people to be saved, not because of their foreknown faith or merit, but because of His sovereign good pleasure and for His glory.

- Two dangers to avoid (*Deut 29:29*)

1. Before creation, God chose...

Jonah 2:9, Eph 1:3-4, John 6:37-39, 17:6

2. A fixed number of people to be saved...

Rom 9:7, 13, 17, Rev 13:8, 20:15, John 10:14-16

3. Not because of their foreknown faith or merit...

Rom 8:29, Deut 7:7-8, Rom 9:11-21

4. But because of His pleasure and for His glory.

Deut 10:14-15, Eph 1:3-12, 1 Cor 1:27-31
