 - 'Many', *Mark 10:45*
 - 'My friends', *John 15:13*
 - 'The church', *Eph 5:25, Acts 20:28*
 - 'The elect', *Rom 8:30-35*
- The Atonement and **Union with Christ**
2 Cor 5:14-15, Rom 6:5
- The **Achievement** of the Atonement
 - Justification & Reconciliation, *Rom 5:9-10*
 - Deliverance from Satan, *Heb 2:14-15*
 - Redemption & Forgiveness, *Eph 1:7*

3. The Wideness of Effectual Atonement

- The language of God's saving love for the **world**
John 3:16-17, 4:42, 1 John 2:2
- The language of Christ's death for **all / everyone**
Titus 2:11, 1 Tim 2:4, 6, 2 Pet 3:9, John 12:32

→ 'World' / 'all' in context → The Two Wills of God
