God's grace in the life of John Calvin (born 1509).

Galatians 2:21...

1. Saving Grace – Calvin, the Justified Sinner (Gal. 2:21b)

- The Greatness of God
- The depths of human sin
- The wonders of salvation: justification, adoption, knowing God.

2. Revealed grace – Calvin, the Bible teacher (2 Tim. 3:16-17)

- Reforming the church through the Word of God
- Encouraging the people of God through God's Predestination and Providence

3. Powerful grace – Calvin, the battered pilgrim (2 Cor 12:9-10)

- Personal hardship
- Faults, real and alleged

Conclusion: Calvin: a man in whom we see God's grace at work (1 Cor 15:10)
