Wisdom on marriage from Proverbs

12:4 A wife of noble character is her husband's crown but a disgraceful wife is like decay in his bones.

18:22 He who finds a wife finds what is good and receives favour from the Lord

19:11 A person's wisdom yields patience; it is to one's glory to overlook an offence.

19:13 A foolish son is his father's ruin, and a quarrelsome wife is like a constant dripping.

19:14 Houses and wealth are inherited from parents but a prudent wife is from the Lord.

21:9 Better to live on a corner of the roof than share a house with a quarrelsome wife.

21:19 Better to live in a desert than with a quarrelsome and ill-tempered wife.

27:15 A quarrelsome wife is like a constant dripping on a rainy day; restraining her is like restraining the wind or grasping oil with the hand.

28:13 Whoever conceals their sins does not prosper, but the one who confesses and renounces them finds mercy.

31:10 A wife of noble character who can find? She is worth far more than rubies.
