- 1:1 The proverbs of Solomon son of David, king of Israel:

  <sup>2</sup> for attaining wisdom and discipline;
  for understanding words of insight;

  <sup>3</sup> for acquiring a disciplined and prudent life,
  doing what is right and just and fair;

  <sup>4</sup> for giving prudence to the simple,
  knowledge and discretion to the young—

  <sup>5</sup> let the wise listen and add to their learning,
  and let the discerning get guidance—

  <sup>6</sup> for understanding proverbs and parables,
  the sayings and riddles of the wise.

  <sup>7</sup> The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge,
  but fools despise wisdom and discipline.
