The dark night – God's judgement against pride Romans 2:1-3:20

• Where we're heading: total human lostness (3:9-20)

1. Beware complacency: God judges everyone fairly

- a) Judgementalism (2:1-3)

 When you condemn others, you condemn yourself
- **b) Opportunity (2:4-5)** *God's delay in punishing gives us time to turn around*
- c) Repentance (2:6-11)
 Only those who've turned around will be truly saved

2. Beware hypocrisy: God cares about what we do

- a) Justification (2:12-13)

 You need heart obedience to be right with God
- b) 'Outsiders' (2:14-16)

 Gentiles with changed hearts get in
- c) 'Insiders' (2:17-24)

 Jews without changed hearts miss out
- **d)** Regeneration (2:25-29)

 But the Holy Spirit can change your heart!
