

- 3. The Law is not enough (vv14-25)





B. PAUL THE NON-CHRISTIAN?

- Sold as slave to sin (v14), prisoner of law of sin (v23)
 [Rom 6:18]
- No Holy Spirit
- 7:5 \rightarrow vv7-25; 7:6 \rightarrow 8:1-17
- Describes defeat not struggle

A. PAUL THE CHRISTIAN?

- Present tense (v14ff)
- Wanting to do good (vv15, 19), delight in God's law (v22)
 [Rom 8:7]
- Two "I"s in action
- = Our experience of struggle



C. PAUL'S CHRISTIAN RETROSPECTIVE?

- Sold as slave to sin (v14),
 Present tense (v14ff) [Rom 6:18]
- No Holy Spirit
- 7:5 \rightarrow vv7-25; 7:6 \rightarrow 8:1-17 \checkmark Two "I"s in action \checkmark

→ Phil 3:4-6

- prisoner of law of sin (v23) Wanting to do good (vv15, 19), delight in God's law (v22) [Rom 8:7]
