Christ died for our sins (v.3)



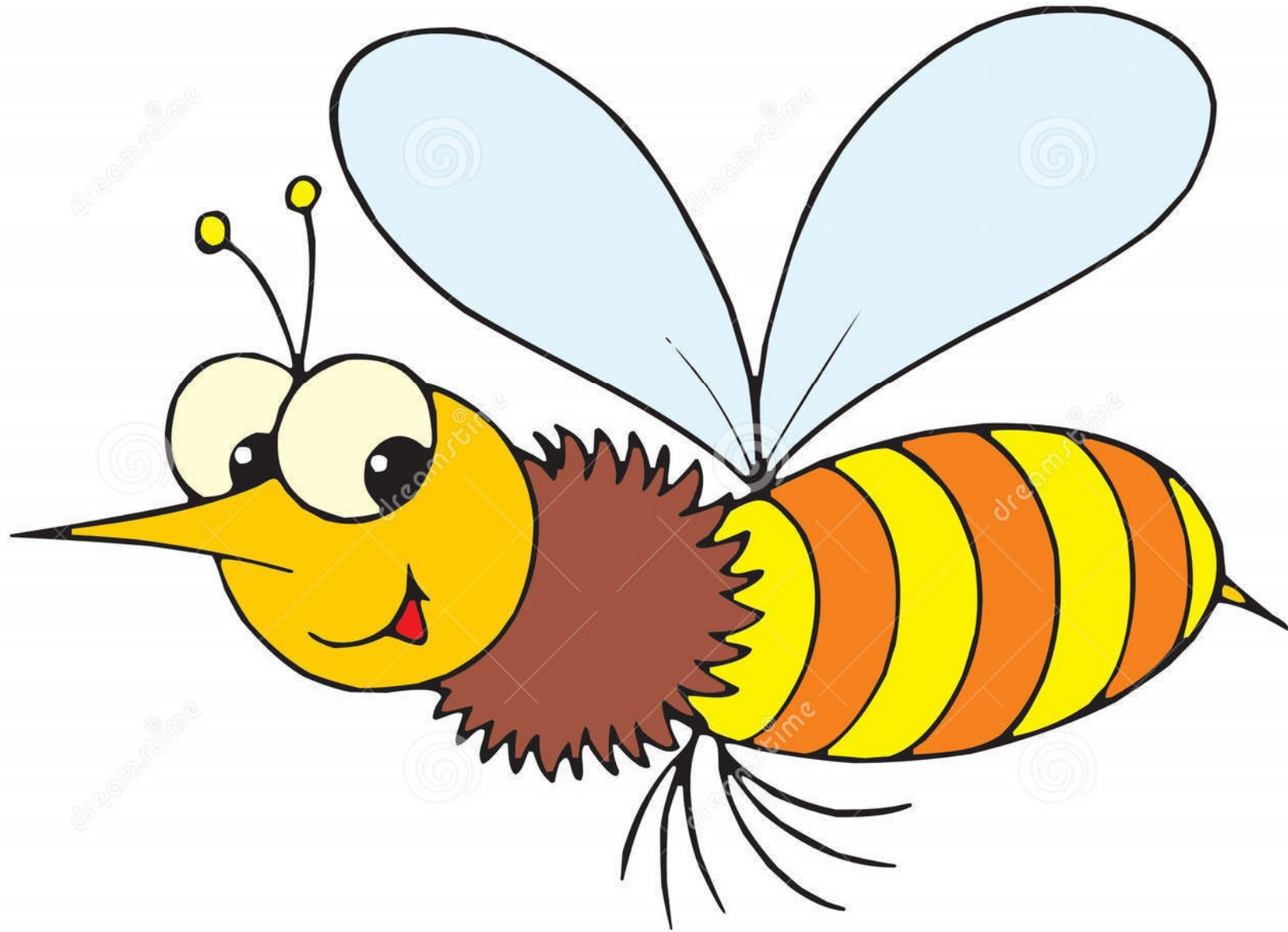

Death thou shalt die.

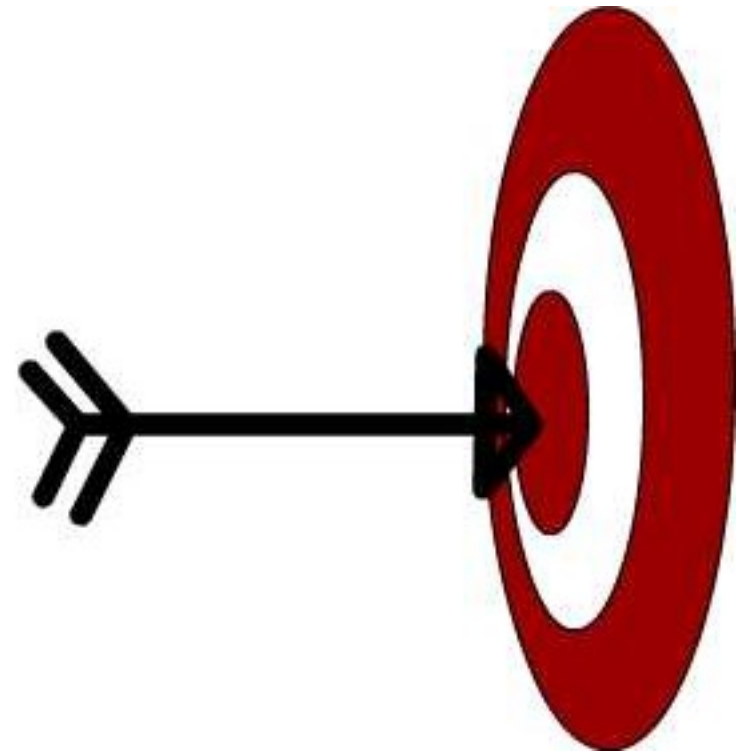
Jesus' Victory can be our victory
