

Don't Look Back in Anger (Oasis)

"Hail him as your matchless king through all eternity"

Crown Him With Many Crowns

"The stone the builders rejected has become the cornerstone; the Lord has done this, and it is marvellous in our eyes."

Psalm 118:22-23

Pause and Reflect

Have you received Jesus as your saviour king?

What would it mean to accept your need for him?

3:5: He <u>looked around</u> at them in anger and, deeply distressed at their stubborn hearts, said to the man, "Stretch out your hand." He stretched it out, and his hand was completely restored.

3:34-35: Then he <u>looked</u> at those seated in a circle <u>around</u> him and said, "Here are my mother and my brothers! Whoever does God's will is my brother and sister and mother.

5:32-4: But Jesus kept <u>looking around</u> to see who had done it. Then the woman, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell at his feet and, trembling with fear, told him the whole truth. He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace and be freed from your suffering."

10:23: Jesus <u>looked around</u> and said to his disciples, "How hard it is for the rich to enter the kingdom of God!"
