

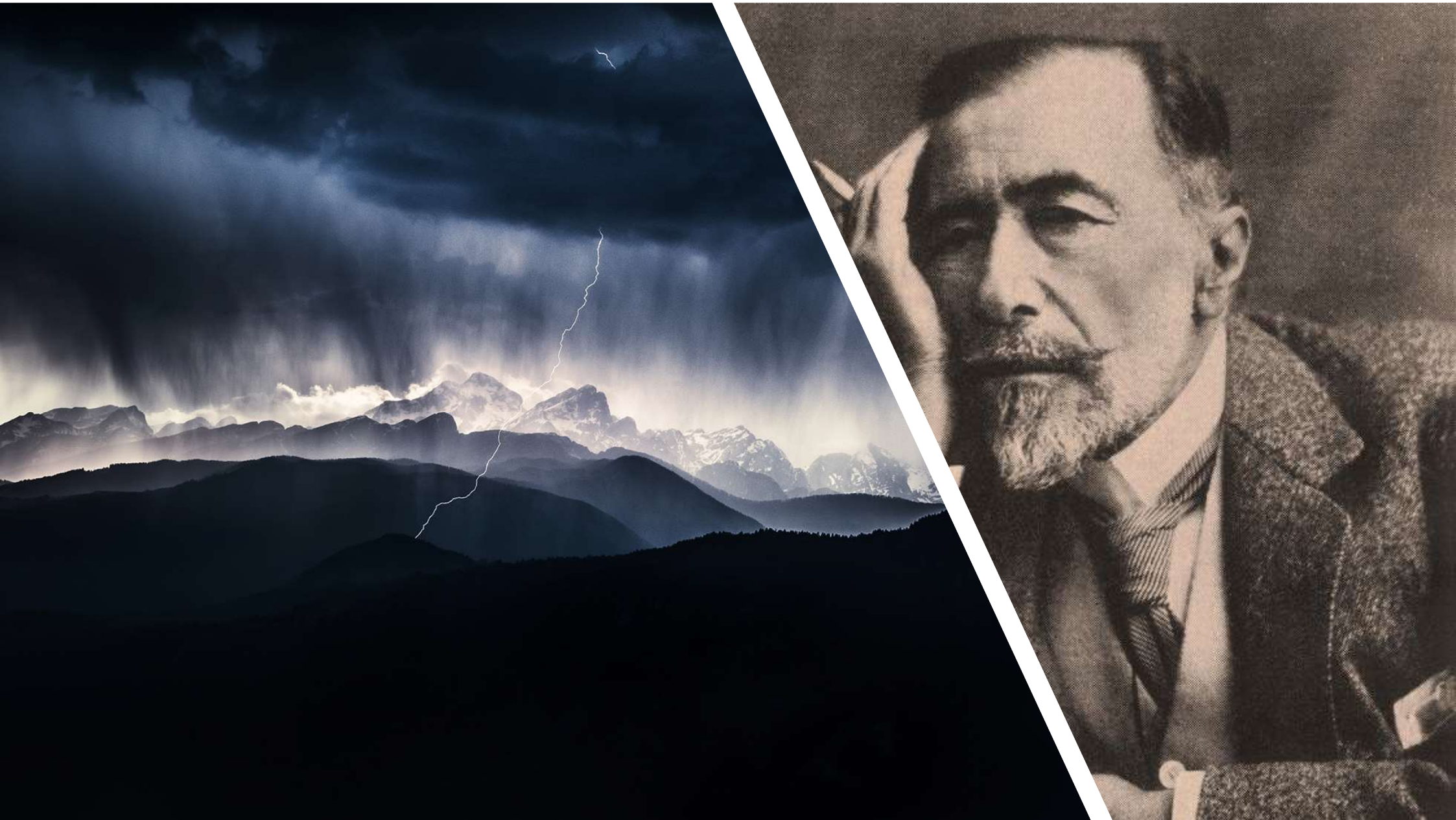

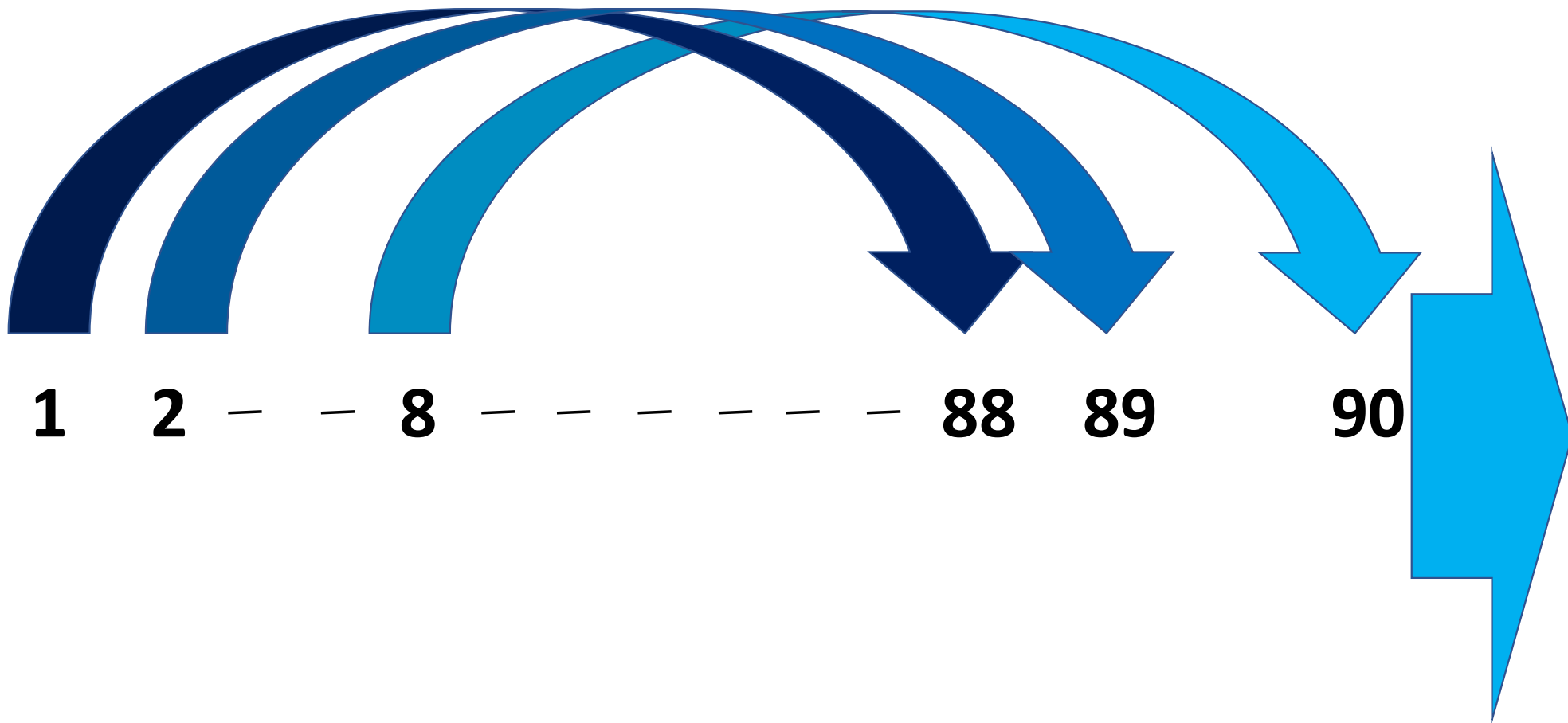

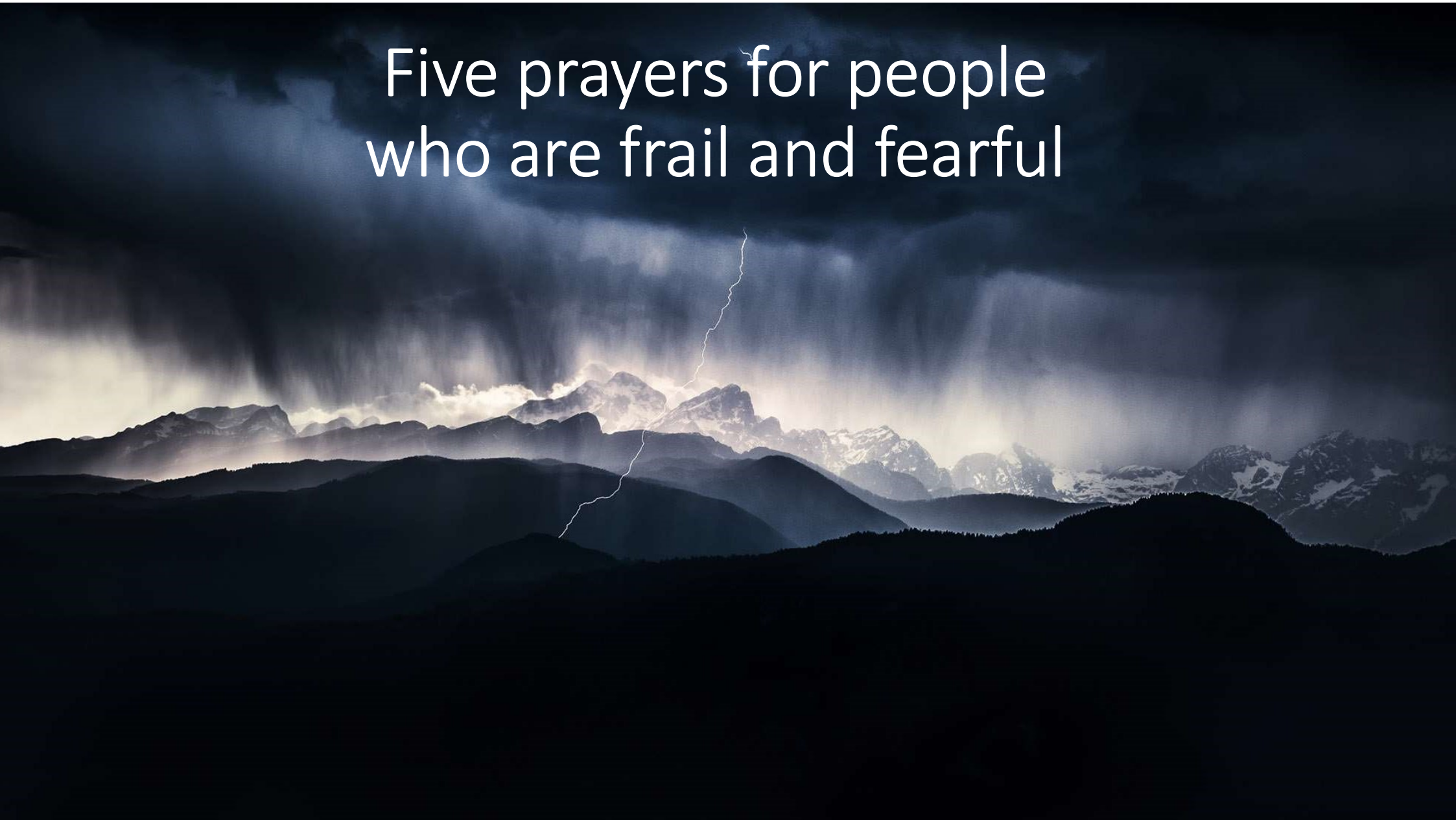


Our fear and his wrath (7-11)

who are frail and fearful






1. To be taught the kind of counting that confers wisdom
