"AREN'T ALL RELIGIONS EQUALLY VALID?": HOW CAN WE SPEAK HELPFULLY ABOUT OTHER FAITHS AND JESUS?

I. THEOLOGY

Exodus 20: ¹And God spoke all these words: ² "I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery. ³ "You shall have no other gods before me.

Isaiah 43: ¹⁰You are my witnesses," declares the LORD, "and my servant whom I have chosen, so that you may know and believe me and understand that I am he. Before me no god was formed, nor will there be one after me. ¹¹ I, even I, am the LORD, and apart from me there is no saviour. ¹² I have revealed and saved and proclaimed-- I, and not some foreign god among you. You are my witnesses," declares the LORD, "that I am God. ¹³ Yes, and from ancient days I am he. No one can deliver out of my hand. When I act, who can reverse it?"

Isaiah 44: ⁸ Do not tremble, do not be afraid. Did I not proclaim this and foretell it long ago? You are my witnesses. Is there any God besides me? No, there is no other Rock; I know not one."

John 14:6 Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

Acts 4:12 Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved."

I Corinthians 10: ¹⁸ Consider the people of Israel: Do not those who eat the sacrifices participate in the altar? ¹⁹ Do I mean then that food sacrificed to an idol is anything, or that an idol is anything? ²⁰ No, but the sacrifices of pagans are offered to demons, not to God, and I do not want you to be participants with demons. ²¹ You cannot drink the cup of the Lord and the cup of demons too; you cannot have a part in both the Lord's table and the table of demons. ²² Are we trying to arouse the Lord's jealousy? Are we stronger than he?

Discussion:

What does the Bible say about the uniqueness of Christ and the exclusiveness of the Gospel? How does the Bible view other faiths?

2. UNDERSTANDING OTHER RELIGIONS

- Multi-faith culture
- Understanding world-views
- The Key questions:
 - Where do we come from?
 - What is the problem with the world?
 - What is the solution?
 - How can we know God(s) and/or meaning?
 - What is your authority?
 - What time is it?
 - What is your identity?
 - What is the future of the world?
- Muslims, Hindus, & Chinese will give different answers to these questions, so listen carefully (one size does not fit all)

3. SPEAKING ABOUT CHRIST

- Show how the Bible & Christ answers the key questions of world views.
- Just explain the Bible's narrative of Creation, fall, Promise of God in OT, Christ, the Church, and the End. Let them then ask their questions.

Discussion:

If you were talking to someone of another faith and they asked you, "So you are a Christian, what do you believe and why?", how would you answer?
