



NAHUM 1

- God is patient
- God is just
- God is good.







The Lord is a jealous and avenging God;

The Lord takes vengeance and is filled with wrath.

The Lord takes vengeance on his foes

And vents his wrath against his enemies.

Nahum 1:2

Do not worship any other god, for the LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God.

Exodus 34:14

Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everyone. If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. Do not take revenge, my dear friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: 'It is mine to avenge; I will repay,' says the Lord.

Romans 12:17-19

Because of your stubbornness and your unrepentant heart, you are storing up wrath against yourself for the day of God's wrath, when his righteous judgment will be revealed.

Romans 2:5

• God is patient: The Lord is slow to anger (v3a)

[The Lord] passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, 'The Lord, the Lord, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness, maintaining love to thousands, and forgiving wickedness, rebellion and sin.'

Exodus 34:6-7a

- God is patient: The Lord is slow to anger (v3a)
 - Patience shown to Ninevah and to people who ignore him and disobey him

The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance. **2 Peter 3:9**

Here is a trustworthy saying that deserves full acceptance: Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners – of whom I am the worst. But for that very reason I was shown mercy so that in me, the worst of sinners, Christ Jesus might display his immense patience as an example for those who would believe in him and receive eternal life.

1 Tim 1:15-16

'You warned them in order to turn them back to your law, but they became arrogant and disobeyed your commands. They sinned against your ordinances, of which you said, "The person who obeys them will live by them." Stubbornly they turned their backs on you, became stiff-necked and refused to listen. For many years you were patient with them. By your Spirit you warned them through your prophets. Yet they paid no attention, so you gave them into the hands of the neighbouring peoples. But in your great mercy you did not put an end to them or abandon them, for you are a gracious and merciful God.'

Yet he does not leave the guilty unpunished; he punishes the children and their children for the sin of the parents to the third and fourth generation
