**20:21-23 JESUS BREATHES OUT WITH PEACE** 

The wind (pneuma) blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the <a href="Spirit">Spirit</a> (pneuma).

Then the LORD God formed a man from the dust of the ground and <u>breathed</u> into his nostrils the <u>breath</u> of life, and the man became a living being.
